

**CITY OF SPRINGVILLE
CITY COUNCIL
SPECIAL CALLED MEETING
August 26, 2019 8:00 a.m.**

After proper notice and advertisement, the City Council of the City of Springville (the "Council") held a special called meeting at 8:00 a.m. on August 26, 2019. The purpose of the meeting was to authorize the mayor to sign an application for ATRIP-II grant funding and to award a paving contract for Bradford Road.

ROLL CALL:

Mayor William Isley said that bids had been accepted and opened for paving on Bradford Road in the areas that are not being repaved by Alabama Power after their recent construction in the area. Only one bid was received and it was from Massey Asphalt Paving in the amount of \$13,950.00 for hauling and installation of city-purchased asphalt.

Sherry Reaves made a motion to approve the bid and authorize Mayor William Isley to enter into a contract with Massey Asphalt Paving in the amount of \$13,950.00. Katrina Hennings seconded the motion. All voted aye.

Richard Caudle with Skipper Consulting Inc presented an application for ATRIP-II grant funding in the amount of \$2,000,000 for improvements at the intersection of US 11 and State Route 174. Katrina Hennings made a motion to authorize Mayor William Isley to sign the application for ATRIP-II grant funding. Sherry Reaves seconded the motion. Sherry Reaves, David Jones, Katrina Hennings, Mayor William Isley, and David Vinson voted aye. Tim Walker, Wayne Tucker, and Herbert Toles voted no. Motion carried.

Wayne Tucker made a motion to adjourn. Katrina Hennings seconded the motion. All voted aye.
