

**CITY OF SPRINGVILLE
CITY COUNCIL
SPECIAL CALLED MEETING
October 7, 2020 8:00 a.m.**

The City Council of the City of Springville held a special called council meeting at 8:00 a.m. on October 7, 2020. The purpose of the meeting was to consider matters related to the response to the COVID19 pandemic and/or to perform essential minimum functions of the government body. The meeting was held by way of teleconference as authorized by a proclamation of Governor Kay Ivey on March 18, 2020.

ROLL CALL:

Mayor William Isley called the meeting to order.

Mayor William Isley presented the bids received for a new sewer force main for the Archer's Cove project.

Mayor William Isley made a motion to accept the low bid of \$353,000.00 from Bolt Contracting. David Jones seconded the motion.

Tim Walker asked questions regarding whether the line would connect to the lift station or to the city sewer system, the type of pipe to be used, and the total amount of the material and installation.

Earl Peoples and Chuck Chitwood with CDG Engineers and Associates gave information that the line will connect to the city sewer and later be connected to the lift station, would be constructed with 8" PVC pipe, and that the bid amount includes the materials and installation.

City Attorney James Hill responded to requests regarding the previously adopted agreement to provide sewer service to the development which will be paid by the owner of the development at no cost to the city. He also advised that the Odenville Utilities Board had confirmed it was prepared and able to begin accepting the agreed upon 200g. / day / house as per the contract and would commence with the permanent infrastructure necessary at this time.

After discussion, a roll call vote was taken with results as follows: Vinson-aye, Hennings-aye, Walker-no, Jones-aye, Reaves-aye, Isley-aye. Motion carried.

With no further business to come before the council, Sherry Reaves made a motion to adjourn. Katrina Hennings seconded the motion. All voted aye.
