February 27, 2017 6:00 p.m.**

Mayor William Isley called the meeting to order and gave the invocation. David Jones led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor William Isley stated that the purpose of the meeting is for the council to consider an annexation petition that has been received from a majority of the residents that live in the Sweetwater subdivision located on Highway 23. The property is not contiguous with the corporate limits of the City and so, for annexation to be affected, the state legislators representing the City are in attendance. Should the City desire the annexation the Council would need to pass a Resolution requesting legislative annexation of the subdivision.

Mayor William Isley introduced Senator Jim McClendon and Representative Jim Hill.

Fire Chief Richard Harvey and Police Chief Bill Lyle presented information related to services provided by the City of Springville.

James Hill discussed the legislative process for annexation of non-contiguous property into the city limits.

Senator Jim McClendon and Representative Jim Hill made comments about the process and their desires / intent as the same related to annexing non-contiguous property into the City.

Mayor William Isley said that the council would consider the Resolution requesting legislative annexation when information was presented indicating the wishes of all property owners within the subdivision and when the council had determined their interest in annexing only the property whose owners were in favor of annexation.

With no further business to come before the council, Wayne Tucker made a motion to adjourn. Katrina Hennings seconded the motion. All voted aye.
