The council heard a presentation from Alex Wolf with PlaSafe regarding mandatory training for youth sports coaches and other personnel who work with players in all youth sports program and discussed adoption of a resolution to regulate the training and authorizing the mayor to enter into a contract for the training.

The council discussed Ordinance 2018-04 to establish a Recreation Board.

The council discussed Ordinance 2018-05 approving the Back to School Sales Tax Holiday as authorized by the state legislature.

Mayor William Isley said that the discussion of the annexation of the Wright Farm property would be moved to a later meeting as the necessary documents have not been provided to prepare the annexation petition and ordinance.

The council discussed reappointment of Miriam Blackwell Brasher to the Historical Commission.

The council discussed the meeting schedule for May, including rescheduling of the May 18 and May 21 work session/regular meeting due to the ALM convention. The council also discussed moving all future regular council work sessions to 3:00p.m.on Wednesdays preceding the regular council meetings.

The council discussed the March 2018 budget report.

The council discussed expenditure by the Beautification Board for planters and plants.

The council discusses issues related to community service and the Litter Clean Up day to be held on April 28
