The council discussed the following expenditure requests:

- Beautification Board additional planters for downtown - \$855.00 (Warren Garden Center)
- Fencing for library - \$1500.00 (Try Me Fencing)
- Fencing for Woody Park - \$225.00 (Try Me Fencing)
- Speedbreaker removal at Pine/Robinson – up to \$1500.00 (Trey Massey)

The council discussed a request for a contribution to the All Stars baseball teams.

The council discussed the May budget report.

The council discussed the FY 19 M4A nutrition contract.

The council discussed an agreement with Spire for installation of a gas line for the new maintenance building at the sports park.

The council discussed a lease-purchase agreement with Axon for new body cameras and tasers for the police department as recommended by the budget committee

The council discussed the purchase of three new defibrillators and autopulse unit for the fire department as recommended by the budget committee.

The council discussed Resolution 2018-16 to complete the probationary period and authorize a pay increase for the police chief.

The council discussed the creation and funding of a Park Director position as recommended by the budget committee and parks and recreation committee.
