The City Council of the City of Springville (the “Council”) held a work session at 3:00 p.m. on August 1, 2018. The purpose of the work session was to discuss the agenda items and potential agenda items.

Mayor William Isley introduced Ashley Lyons who has been hired as an administrative assistant in the parks and recreation department.

The council discussed a bid received from Massey Asphalt Paving for paving the VFW road and parking lot in the amount of \$52,064.50.

The council discussed the following expenditure requests:

James Hill discussed the MacDonald Farms agreement and the removal of the resolution regarding weed abatement in MacDonald Farms from the agenda.

James Hill discussed licensing agreements for use of city park property.

The council discussed a special called meeting to be scheduled for August 27 to hold a public hearing regarding a proposed ordinance to zone newly annexed property and to consider the proposed ordinance.

The council discussed the June budget report.

The council discussed advertisement in the St. Clair Times football edition and the SHS football program.

The council discussed a proposed agreement with the St. Clair County Commission regarding participating in a program to provide school resource officers at a cost of \$7,500.00.

The council discussed the need for trimming of tree branches overhanging city streets.
