**Public Hearing-Liquor License Application**

David Jones made a motion to open a public hearing regarding the application for a Restaurant Retail Liquor License submitted by Su Mei Lin dba Azteca's Mexican Grill Springville LLC. John Coyne seconded the motion. All voted aye.

Mayor William Isley asked for public comments regarding the license application. None were heard.

John Coyne made a motion to close the public hearing. Herbert Toles seconded the motion. All voted aye.

Mayor William Isley called the regular meeting to order and gave the invocation. John Coyne led the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Recommendation of Police Building Committee**

Mayor William Isley said that upon the recommendation of the police building committee the city would proceed with the plan that the existing building be dismantled and re-erected on the site of the public works building to be used as a shop. Bids have been let for purchase and construction of a new one story 6000 square foot building to be built on the existing site, with the public works employees to do some of the site preparation work.

**Muriel Edwards-Jefferson State**

Muriel Edwards was not present.

**Presentation from Signtronix for LED sign**

John Howell and Ron Gither from Signtronix presented information and demonstrated signs available for purchase. After discussion, the council agreed to consider the matter at the next meeting.

**Presentation from JA Dawson for Splash Pad**

John Kilpatrick from JA Dawson & Company, Inc. presented a proposal for a splash pad for Big Springs Park. Mayor William Isley said that funding for the project is available without using general fund money. After discussion, the council agreed to consider the matter at the next meeting.

**Restaurant Retail Liquor License**

John Coyne made a motion to approve the application for a Restaurant Retail Liquor License submitted by Su Mei Lin dba Azteca's Mexican Grill Springville LLC. David Jones seconded the motion. All voted aye except Mayor Isley who abstained. Motion carried.

**Library Board Appointment**

After discussion of a request to replace Katie Bryan on the Library Board, the council agreed that this was not a council appointment and removed the item from the agenda.

**Ordinance 2011-01 Sale of Surplus Property (Crown Binder Building)**

Mayor William Isley presented Ordinance 2011-01 authorizing the sale of the Crown Binder Building to Robbie and Robin Franklin, who intend to restore the building based on photographs of the original structure. The purchasers have agreed to attempt to have the building structurally sound within 90 days and fully restored within one year.

David Jones made a motion to suspend the rules for immediate consideration of Ordinance 2011-01. Brian Skinner seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken and all voted aye.

Brian Skinner made a motion to adopt the ordinance. Herbert Toles seconded the motion. All voted aye except Mayor Isley who abstained. Motion carried.

**Minutes of December 6, 2010 Regular Meeting and Work Session**

David Jones made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting and work session held on December 6, 2010. John Coyne seconded the motion. All voted aye.

**November 2010 Financial Report**

Hugh Marlin made a motion to approve the financial report for November 2010. David Jones seconded the motion. All voted aye.

**Reschedule Regular Meeting of January 17, 2011**

David Jones made a motion to reschedule the regular meeting of January 17, 2011 to January 10, 2011 at 4:00 p.m. due to the Martin Luther King Jr. holiday. John Coyne seconded the motion. All voted aye.

**David Jones – Stipend for Lt. Lyle**

David Jones made a motion to adopt a resolution paying a \$1,000.00 stipend to Lt. Bill Lyle for his work during the absence of Chief Charles. John Coyne seconded the motion. All voted aye.

**Mayor’s Report**

Mayor William Isley said that the property survey for the dialysis center property is complete and he hopes to close on the sale within two weeks.

Mayor William Isley said that Mollie Lyle has resigned to accept a position with Vance and Associates.

Mayor William Isley said that he is in preliminary discussions with Hibbett’s Sporting Goods to locate at Springville Station.

**Surplus Vehicles**

Richard Harvey reported that the ambulance and two police cars have been sold through GovDeals.com and that an additional police car is listed. Public works vehicles will be listed soon.

**John Coyne – Park Security**

John Coyne asked that the council consider purchasing better surveillance cameras for Big Springs Park. Mayor William Isley asked Chief Greg Charles to study the cameras and make a recommendation to the council within one month.
