Mayor William Isley called the regular meeting to order and gave the invocation. David Jones led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Amendments to Agenda

Wayne Tucker made a motion to amend the agenda to include a request for a donation to the 11 and 12 year old baseball team that will be playing in the World Series. Herbert Toles seconded the motion. All voted aye.

The council discussed rescheduling the August 5th meeting due to the mayor's absence; the meeting date was not amended.

Baseball Team Contribution

Mayor William Isley made a motion to make a \$750.00 contribution to the 11 and 12 year old baseball team through the Chamber of Commerce to assist with expenses to travel to the World Series. Chip Martin seconded the motion. All voted aye.

Renew RDS Contracts

Mayor's Report

Mayor William Isley said that he, Hugh Marlin, and Wayne Tucker would be meeting with ALDOT officials in Montgomery regarding the Walker Drive improvement project on July 16.

Mayor William Isley said that the police building will be ready to move into by the end of the year.

Mayor William Isley said that the budget committee has reported that they do not have enough information on the FY 2014 budget ready to include funding for a CDBG grant for street paving as discussed in a previous meeting.

Mayor William Isley said that the Farmers Market will open on Friday and will be open every day for the remainder of the season with no charge to set up to sell produce.

The council discussed issues relating to debris and garbage pick up.

James Hill said that the contract for the work on Purple Heart Blvd has been sent to the county engineer for approval.
