

**CITY OF SPRINGVILLE
CITY COUNCIL
SPECIAL CALLED WORK SESSION
January 23, 2019 2:00 p.m.**

After proper notice and advertisement, the City Council of the City of Springville (the “Council”) held a work session at 2:00 p.m. on January 23, 2019. The purpose of the work session was to discuss sewer infrastructure issues

ROLL CALL:

Earl Peoples presented information to the council regarding a sewer infiltration study, sewer sanitary overflow program, and manhole mapping requirement that would be used to determine the cost to correct any infiltration problems that would be found, and would put in place the ADEM-required Sewer Sanitary Overflow Program and mapping of existing manholes. The council requested that the study be placed on the next council agenda for consideration.

Earl Peoples presented information to the council regarding providing sewer service to the Wright Farm development by creating a connection to Odenville’s sewer system so that sewer flows could be pumped to Odenville’s sewer treatment plant.

The council discussed projected fees per house to be collected by Springville, projected charges from Odenville, legal requirements for a contract for the project, and engineering studies to determine the necessary infrastructure for the project.

Odenville Water and Sewer Superintendent Jimmy Bailey answered questions from the council regarding Odenville’s participation in the project and Robert Wilkes addressed the council regarding the Wright Farm development.

The council also discussed the option of building a sewer treatment plant or partnering with Odenville for construction of a plant to provide for future sewer needs in the city.

The council asked that specific information regarding infrastructure and legal issues be provided before the matter is brought before the council for action.

With no further business to come before the council, the work session was adjourned at 4:20 p.m.
