Mayor William Isley stated that the purpose of the meeting was to discuss application for an APPLE grant to study traffic issues in the area of US 11 and Marietta Road and on County Road 9.

Kelly Huffstutler gave information regarding the proposed development of a residential subdivision on the Wright Farm property which, if developed, would create additional traffic at the 4-way stop.

David Jones exited the meeting at approximately 4:20p.m.

Richard Caudle with Skipper Consulting discussed the proposed application with St. Clair County for an APPLE grant to study the traffic in the area and determine ways to alleviate congestion in the area of the 4 way stop at US 11 and Marietta Road. Dan Dahlke, County Engineer, discussed the available APPLE grant funding of \$60,000.00 which has a 20% match of \$12,000.00 which would be shared by the city and the county.

Katrina Hennings made a motion to approve funding for the city's portion of the APPLE grant match. David Vinson seconded the motion. David Vinson, Katrina Hennings, and Mayor William Isley voted aye. Tim Walker and Herbert Toles voted no. Motion carried.
