Mayor William Isley called the regular meeting to order and gave the invocation. John Coyne led the Pledge of Allegiance.

League of Municipalities Conference

Mayor Isley asked all council members who plan to attend the Alabama League of Municipalities Annual Conference April 30-May 3 to notify the clerk so that registrations can be sent.

Revisions to Agenda

Hugh Marlin made a motion to amend the agenda to allow a report from the budget committee. Wayne Tucker seconded the motion. All voted aye.

Minutes of February 7, 2011 Regular Meeting

David Jones made a motion to approve the minutes of the February 7 regular meeting. Herbert Toles seconded the motion. All voted aye.

January 2011 Financial Report

The January 2011 Financial Report was presented. Mayor William Isley said that the budget committee had met to discuss the purchase of a motor grader. David Jones reported on the revenue comparison from January 31, 2010 to January 31, 2011 which indicates an increase in certain revenues. David Jones made a recommendation from the budget committee to allocate funds for the purchase of the motor grader. After discussion regarding the bid process, David Jones withdrew his recommendation until the bids are returned.

David Jones made a motion to approve the January 2011 Financial Report. John Coyne seconded the motion. All voted aye.

Resolution 2011-05 Agreement with ALDOT for Streetscape

Wayne Tucker made a motion to adopt Resolution 2011-05 entering into an agreement with ALDOT to extend the expiration date of the Streetscape project until January 17, 2013. John Coyne seconded the motion. All voted aye.

Richard Harvey-Addition to HazMat Building

Sports Complex Progress

Mayor William Isley gave a report on the progress on the Sports Complex project. The tree removal is almost complete and will be followed by a bid for stump removal and installation of a silt fence. Mayor William Isley said that he has been meeting with the sports groups to form an umbrella group that will oversee the sports programs when the complex is complete.

Mayor's Report

Mayor William Isley said the colors have been chosen for the splash pad and the project will begin soon.

Mayor William Isley said that he will meet this week with Spencer Bacchus to discuss possible funding assistance for projects.

Mayor William Isley said that the request for qualifications for architects is out on the senior center project.

Mayor William Isley announced that the 5K run will be held on April 2.

Mayor William Isley said that Chief Charles will report on the prices for cameras for the park at the next meeting.

Mayor William Isley reported that the Press Release page on the website is up and asked that notification be given to citizens regarding this information.
